
The School Aged Immunisation Service will soon be visiting your child's school to deliver their 3-in-1 Teenage Booster and Meningococcal ACWY vaccination.

The e-consent link will close at **8am** on the morning of the session in your child's school, your school will advise you of this date.



If you have more than 1 child at the school, you will need to complete a separate form for each child.

Please check it is the <u>child's</u> name and date of birth on the form, not your own and check information is correct before submitting.



Following your submission please contact us if:

- Your child has their vaccines at their GP surgery.
- Your child is given a vaccine in A&E/Urgent Care following a tetanus prone injury.
- Your child's health changes.
- If you wish to change your mind and wish to withdraw your e-consent.
- If you have any further questions.



If you do NOT want your child to receive the vaccinations, please complete and return the form <u>declining</u> your consent and your child will not be offered their vaccinations.
