## Study Leave - Year 12 End of Year Assessment Week 2023

Year 12 End of Year Assessments will take place from Tuesday 2nd May to Friday 5th May 2023.

## A level subjects

During assessment week lessons for all A level subjects will not be taught, students must use this time for authorised study either in school or at home.

## Students studying BTEC only

Students studying solely BTEC subjects must attend all BTEC lessons (with the exception of strike day on Tuesday 2nd) but may take authorised study leave if sitting an actual BTEC exam. Study leave can be taken in the morning or afternoon session preceding their exam. Students should advise their subject teacher and 6th form administrator if this is their intention, and should also check if any group revision session being offered during the timetabled lesson would be more beneficial.

## Students studying BTEC and A Level

For students studying subjects at A level and BTEC subjects, they may choose to take authorised study leave from BTEC lessons in the morning or afternoon session preceding their A level assessment or BTEC exam.

For example, morning assessment - study period will be the afternoon session of the previous day; afternoon assessment - study period will be the morning session on the day of assessment.

Individual students taking authorised study leave from BTEC lessons should inform their subject teacher and the 6<sup>th</sup> form administrator at their home base school of their intention to be absent from the lesson to ensure this is not recorded as unauthorised absence.
